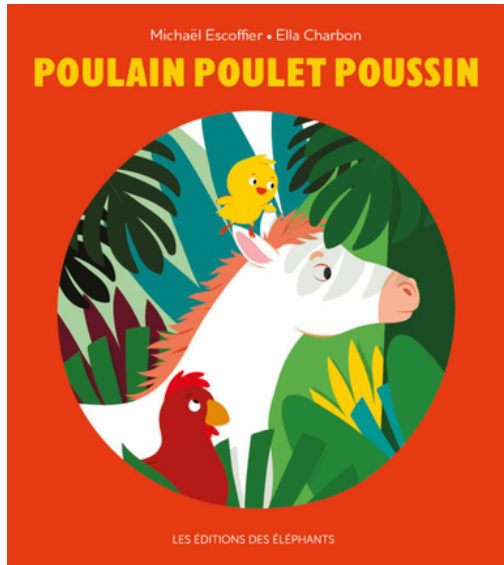
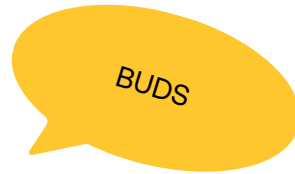


Poulain Poulet Poussin

7. humide (oo-meed): humid
8. l'arc-en-ciel (lark-on-syell): the rainbow
9. la forêt (for-ay): the forest
10. l'eau (low): the water
11. la balade (ba-lad): the walk, the stroll
