

1. Immense (ee-mahns): Huge
2. Grand (grahn): Big
3. Rapide (rah-peed): Fast
4. Lent (lahn," with a nasal 'n' at the end): Slow
5. À deux (ah duh): Together - by two
6. Rêveur (ruh-vuhr): Day-dreamer
7. Pareil (pah-ray): Same
8. Uni (oo-nee): Solid color
9. À l'endroit (ah lehn-druh-wah): Right side up
10. À l'envers (ah l'ahn-vair): Upside down
11. Tout au fond (toot oh fohn without pronouncing the n): At the very bottom
12. Équilibre (ay-kee-lee-bruh): Steady
